

RIGHTS OF THE PERSON SERVED

All Persons Served have the right to:

- Be accommodated fairly and respectfully
- Privacy and confidentiality of information
- Freedom from abuse, financial or other exploitation, retaliation, humiliation and neglect
- A clear and supported complaint process
- Refuse services from NYRC with the provision of consequences
- Receive services in a manner that is noncoercive
- Receive services in a manner that allows for selfdetermination
- Have legal guardians (substitute decision makers) participate in decision making
